

There Are Many Ways You Can Support Partner Agencies of The Jewish Foundation of Memphis

ASBEE

\$100 – \$500 will purchase new sets of reference books in both Hebrew and English;
\$1,500 will fund the Spring Institute of Jewish Learning;
\$2,000 will provide scholarships for Junior and Senior NCSY conventions;
\$2,500 will fund weekly babysitting during Shabbat service;
\$2,200 will fund a lowering device for the cemetery.

\$2,500 will fund publication of *Inside ASBEE* 5-6 times a year;
\$3,000 will fund transportation to an NCSY Shabbaton;
\$6,500 will purchase new computers for ASBEE office;
\$10,000 will cover annual expenses for a Shilichot from Israel;
\$25,000 is needed to repave the cemetery parking lot;

\$350 will sponsor one teen night in our newly renovated teen lounge;
\$750 will purchase a projector for special events;

Jewish Family Service

A **\$100** "Friends of Seniors" donation will support the annual Senior Resource Fair conducted by JFS Jewish Council On Aging, all funds raised will go toward programs and services for seniors;
\$270 will subsidize an in-home assessment and evaluation for an older adult served in our Senior Connection program;
\$500 will provide 20 Kroger food vouchers of \$25 each for needy Jewish families;

\$500 will underwrite the cost of supplies and refreshments for one year for JFS Out On A Limb support group for amputees and their families;
\$600 is needed to provide prescription drug assistance for one senior adult for one year; **\$10,000** endows all the medication needs for one individual every year;
\$2,500 will fund a full month of food, shelter & utilities for Jewish families in need.
\$3,000 will purchase 3 laptop computers and software upgrades for Adoption Connection, Senior Connections and the JFS counseling program.

\$20,000 will provide four new dryers needed for the laundry.

\$600 will sponsor a pre-school session at summer camp for young campers whose families have been negatively impacted in the current economic downturn by a sudden job loss.

Temple Israel
