

Wish Lists for Partner Agencies of The Jewish Foundation of Memphis

ASBEE

\$100 – \$500 will purchase new sets of reference books in both Hebrew and English;

\$1,500 will fund an Akiva Institute;

\$2,000 will provide scholarships for Junior and Senior NCSY conventions;

\$2,500 will fund weekly babysitting during Shabbat service;

\$2,200 will fund a lowering device for the cemetery;

\$2,500 will fund publication of *Inside ASBEE* 5-6 times a year;

\$3,000 will fund transportation to an NCSY Shabbaton;

\$6,500 will purchase new computers for ASBEE office;

\$10,000 will cover annual expenses for youth leaders;

\$75 will purchase new DVD player;
\$350 will purchase a high quality digital camera;
\$350 is needed for a commercial grade vacuum cleaner;
\$360 is needed to purchase preschool enrichment supplies;
\$400 is needed to send our Executive Director to a grant-writing seminar;
\$450 will purchase 6 new tables for the lunchroom;
\$800 is needed to fund monthly teacher appreciation breakfast throughout the school year;
\$850 will purchase a project to work with Smartboard technology in the classroom;

Memphis Jewish Home and Rehabilitation Center

\$300 will provide birdseed for a year for the Home's birds;
\$1,000 will provide special High Holy Day meals at Rosh Hashanah and Break-Fast after Yom Kippur for 2011;
\$1,800 will provide a Shabbat luncheon for residents and volunteers for three months;
\$3,500 will renovate a resident's room including new furniture, flooring and paint which currently dates back 19 years to 1992 grand opening;
\$4,000 will provide a char broiler for the meat kitchen;
\$7,000 will maintain the large fish tank for a year;
\$18,000 will provide art therapy for residents for one year. Art therapist is used 26 hours/month;

\$45,000-\$50,000 will cover the gap in actual cost of care and government reimbursement for a Jewish Medicaid resident for one year;
\$50,000 - \$80,000 will provide a new sound system for the auditorium;
\$80,000 will repave the parking lot;
\$80,000 will renovate the upstairs porch into useable space for long term care residents year-round. Current design is not year-round and obstructs garden view for wheelchair bound residents.

\$25 will cover gas for one day for the Senior Adult Van;
\$125-\$190 will fund a week of financial assistance for a preschool child;
\$150-\$500 will fund an Indoor/Outdoor tables and play equipment for the ECC;
\$600 will fund one week of the Senior Adult Transportation Service;
\$900 will fund a new desktop computer (6 needed);

\$1,000 will fund a large screen, wall-mounted TV/DVD unit for the Kopald Senior Adult Lounge;
\$4,000 will fund a large format laser printer;
